Project Leads/Lead Analysts are responsible for managing and delivering entire data analysis programmes or portfolios of high value products. Projects include benchmarking, bespoke client assignments, assisting with the management of specific client accounts or the development of internal methodology and processes.

Project Leads/Lead Analysts work on large data sets, handling and examining data & specifications to identify client insights, helping to improve efficiency and business performance.

The successful candidate will enjoy regular client-facing exposure and demonstrate domain expertise.

Key responsibilities include:

- Delivering at least one entire data analysis programme, and potentially several smaller projects
- Effectively leading client and internal meetings
